ANDASIBE

The Andasibe Mantadia National Park was founded in 1989 and covers two areas with its 154 km². Both parts belonged to the same wet forest and were divided into two parts due to human activities.

You can discover different flora and fauna in this park, especially what makes Madagascar so unique.

In the Andasibe Mantadia National Park orchids, (screw) palms, the heavy precious wood rosewood and The "peeling tree" Vakoana as well as all kinds of endemic colorful flowers grow. Three quarters of the 1200 plant species are found only here in Andasibe Mantadia National Park. Most of the trees bloom all year round. In addition, the small rivers are home to some endemic fish and hundreds of insects, including some exceptionally large and colorful butterflies.



RANOMAFANA

Ranomafana is without doubt one of the most spectacular national parks of Madagascar and together with Isalo and Andasibe N.P. one of the most visited national parks of the island.

12 species of lemurs are indigenous to the area and are easy to observe for the pleasure of the tourists. A special attraction are the golden bamboo lemurs, some of which are not far from the entrance. There are also other mammals such as 7 species of tenrecs, carnivorous bats, the Malagasy striped civet and some mongooses in the beautiful Ranomafana National Park. There are at least 115 cataloged bird species, 30 of which are endemic to this area and are at home in Ranomafana.



NOSY

The name of Nosy Varika would come from the presence of many lemurs in the forests that once surrounded the city. Nosy Varika is a charming locality landlocked on the east coast of Madagascar, located 115 km from Mananjary. It is built on the Sakaleona river, surrounded by the freshwater canals of the Canal des Pangalanes. In the past, it was known as the "Makis Island", but without really any makis on the horizon. With a feeling of being at the end of the world cloistered in a unique and enchanting landscape, Nosy varika is the ideal place to recharge your batteries in serenity and find yourself. Its subtropical vegetation remains one of the most varied of the Big Island. It is rather inhabited by a very warm human population. A population that lives entirely from what Mother Nature has given it as a heritage: agriculture, fishing and culture. Rice, tropical fruits, food products and seafood ensure the self-subsistence of the inhabitants who have developed an essential value of their society: sharing. A trip to Nosy Varika is really a return to a very pleasant primitive way of life, far from the worries of the urban world.

MANAKARA

Discovery of the Commissioner's Hole and a canoe trip on the famous Pangalane Canal. The majority of the inhabitants of Manakara belong to the ethnic group of the Antaimoro or Antimorona (morona means shore). The daily activities of the inhabitants consist of fishing, carpet weaving, canoe building and the production of Antaimoro paper. This product has established the reputation of the region and is used to make scrolls, cards or postcards.



TRIPS TO FIANARANTSOA

The trip from Manakara to Fianarantsoa stretches over a total distance of just over 160 kilometers, crossing more than 60 bridges and through almost 50 different tunnels. The journey is carried out at a speed of about 15 kilometers per hour, and the doors normally remain open during the journey.

In most other European countries, train travel has become so commonplace that few people can enjoy it. In Madagascar, the rules are quite different, because a train ride is much more spectacular on the island and is by far not possible everywhere. On the way you can observe nature and the green landscape as well as the small village and its inhabitants in the middle of the road.



FIANARANTSOA

In the south of Madagascar lies the city of Fianarantsoa. The capital of the Betsileo tribe, built on the top of the Ivone hill, is located about 400 km from Antananarivo. The translation of the place name would be Fianarantsoa, the city where good is learned. It is also the place where you can taste good wine. On the way to the small town you will discover a more modern city, where the commercial and

The industrial area is located, which contributes to the economy of the region. The third level of Fianarantsoa, called Upper Town, on the other hand, is the true sanctuary of the remains of the past and the history of the town.



NOSY TANIKELY

Nosy Tanikely means "island of little earth", which alludes to the small area of the island. But under water there is much more to see: The colorful, still completely intact coral gardens reach to a few meters before the beach, and accommodate an unbelievable abundance of fish, starfish, sea urchins, sea cucumbers and other sea creatures. Between huge corals, surgeonfish, pufferfish and groupers find a home. Whole shoals of fish pass by dazzlingly colorful, and with the underwater camera you sometimes don't even know where to take pictures first.



ANTANANARIVO

Antananarivo abbreviated Tana, formerly also Tananarive is the capital and with 2 610,000 inhabitants (2015) also by far the largest city of Madagascar [1]. The administrative seat of the province Antananarivo is located at an altitude of up to 1435 m above sea level in the central mountainous region of the island. Antananarivo is the geographical, administrative and industrial center of the country.
